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**Abstract:** Historical materialism emphasizes that production is the primary premise of human history. Postmodernist thinker Baudrillard thus regards Marx's theory of production as a complicit ideology of bourgeois "productivism". In essence, Marx's theory of production contains dual dimensions of ontological inquiry and social critique. Baudrillard ignores this inherent unity and solely focuses critique on the ontological dimension of "production" disregarding its critical implications for capitalist production

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
